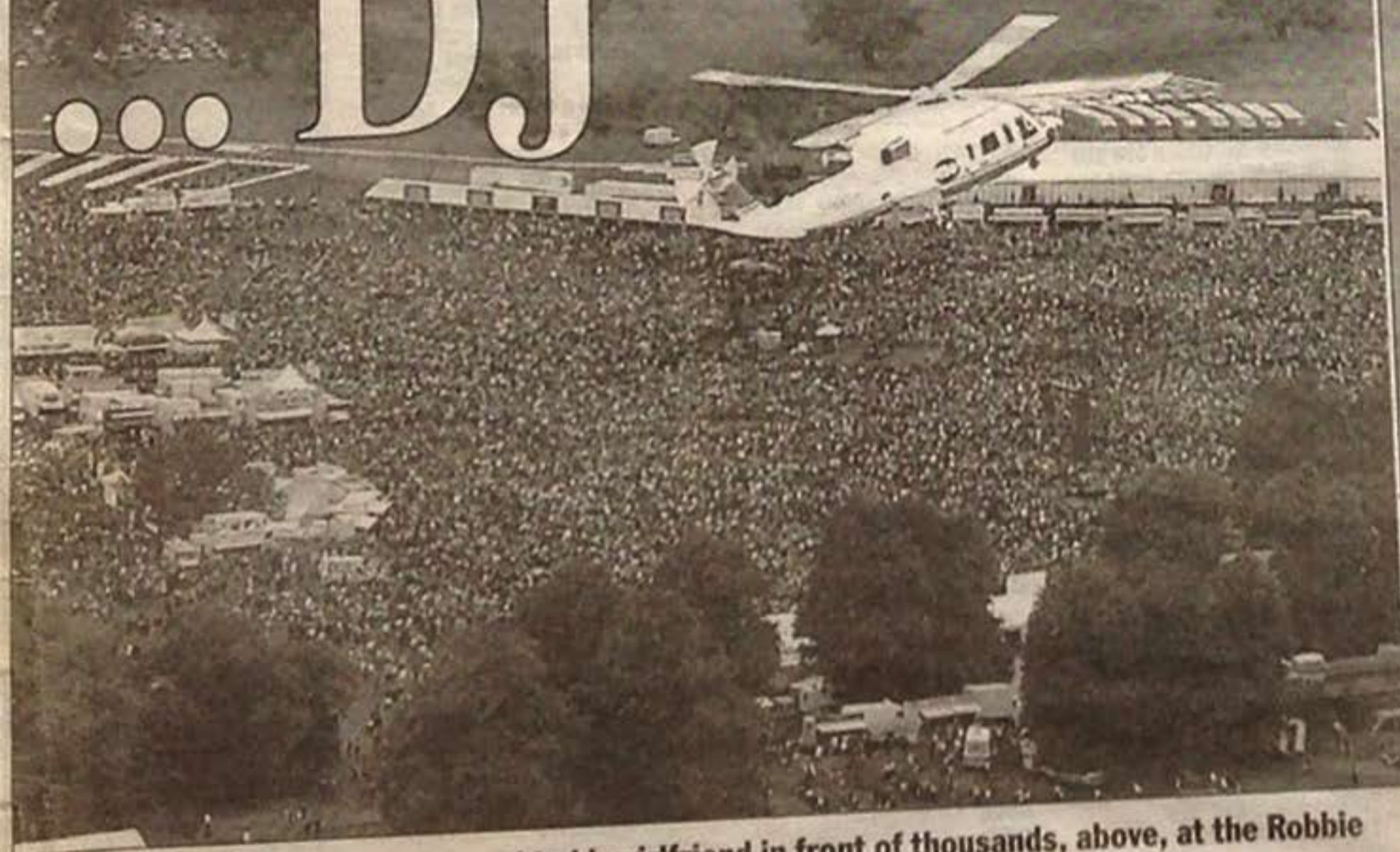

Pep proposed to Natalie during the afternoon before Robbie came on stage and she accepted.

But as the evening progressed, Pep grabbed Robbie's attention by writing a note which read: "DJ

today: She's The One." The entertainer put the letter in his pocket, only to retrieve it shortly before singing his song of the same name.

He called on Pep to propose to Natalie again, before dedicating the song to them.

Pep, said: "I think he appreciated somebody being romantic because he's a very emotional person himself.

"He told me Natalie was fit which I already knew but it's even better when Robbie Williams tells you that. I think the guy's a great showman."
